

Size of Collections

Printed Volumes in Physical Location

This chart tracks cataloged printed volumes that are held in each building. A sample of stacks holdings in the University Library has showed that the numbers previously reported diverge from items in the stacks plus items checked out. We have established a new baseline for each building using either numbers from the sample or numbers from Sirsi, whichever is most appropriate. Ivy Stacks numbers are from the Ivy inventory database; those numbers are subtracted from the totals for the professional schools and Special Collections to arrive at their in-building totals.

Other Media

At the completion of the Ivy Stacks renovation in 2012, a new baseline for Ivy Stacks holdings was established. AV, electronic, and microformat materials in Ivy are counted by the box rather than by the item, as is done in the rest of the collection. Figures for Ivy Stacks are taken from the Ivy Inventory. Items in the Ivy Annex are counted using Directors Station.

Digital Collections Not Purchased

These data account for locally produced digital objects, which are available to users, and where library staff are involved in the creation and/or management of the objects or metadata and are responsible for continued preservation of the objects. In some cases, the digital file and the metadata file for the same object may be provided by two different library units.

¹ Examples include images, music/audio, video, e-texts, GIS data, datasets, PDFs, EADs, TEIs, XML documents, etc. Count all iterations of a digital object, e.g., multiple copies of the same object would be counted, or if a digital book has files for each page, count each page as an object.

² E.g., cataloging and metadata records: the discovery record that creates access for the user.

³ The intellectual unit is counted once. Do not count multiple iterations (e.g., copies, volumes, or multiple images of the Mona Lisa). Do count different intellectual units of an object (e.g., a scanned book may have multiple editions each of which should be counted).

⁴ Digital Curation Services size in gigabytes was inadvertently double-counted in FY12. The number is corrected for FY13. FY15 WSLs and Music were absorbed into the DCS count.
