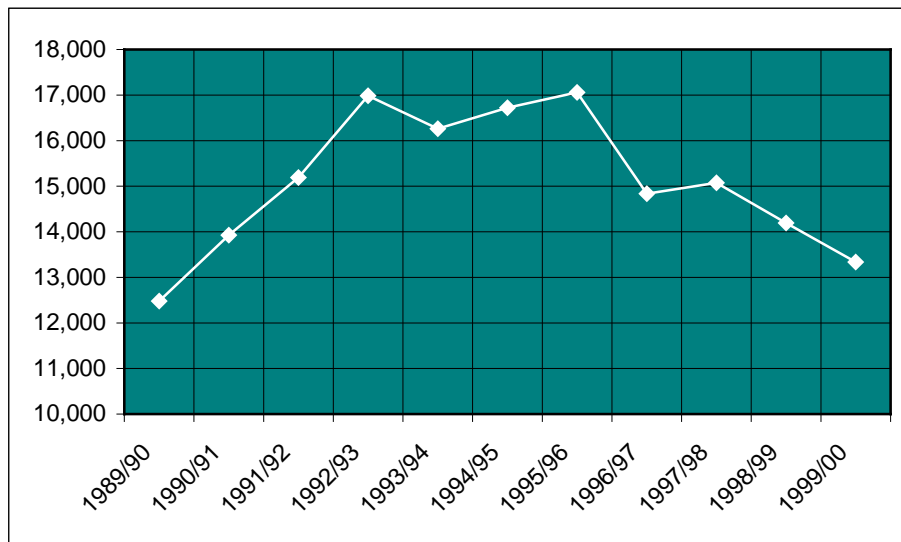

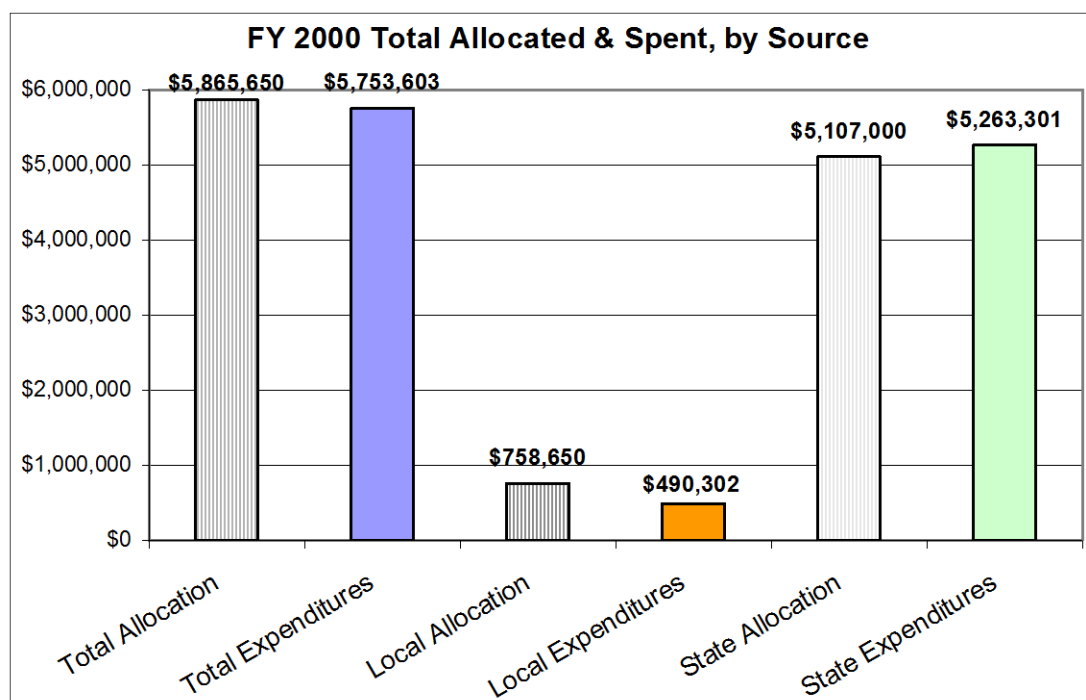

*Budget allocations*

The state allocation for the materials budget was \$5,107,000. Local funds added an allocation of \$758,650, for a total materials budget of \$5,865,650. Thus 87% of the total budget came from state funds, and 13% from local funds.

*Expenditures Summary*

State expenditures amounted to \$5,263,301 (103% of the state budget allocation\*). Expenditures from local funds were \$490,302 (65% of the local budget allocation). Total expenditures were \$5,753,603 (98% of the total allocation). As is made clear in the chart below, the funds from local sources are a small proportion of the total.



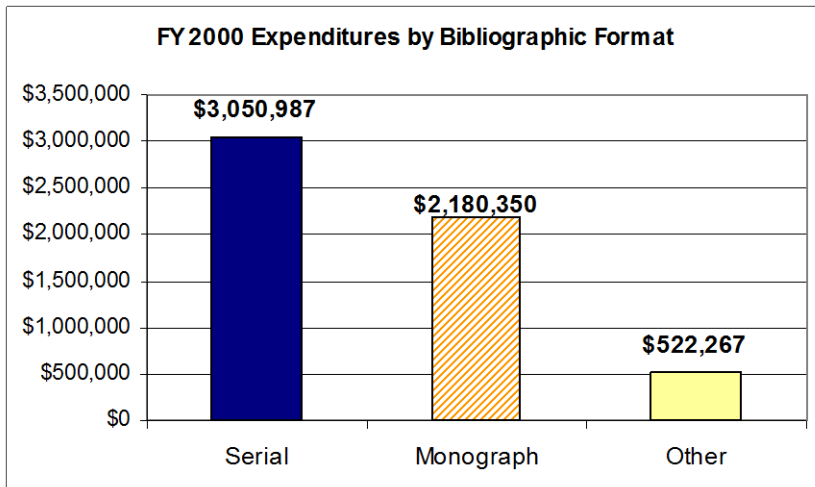
**UVA Library Materials Budget, FY 2000: Total Budgeted & Spent by Source**

\*The Library overspent the state budget allocation because it purchased a major database (the Web of Science) with the assistance of a number of academic units, and some of the outside contributions were received after the close of the fiscal year. Using those contributions, the Library will reimburse the University for the deficit in FY2001.

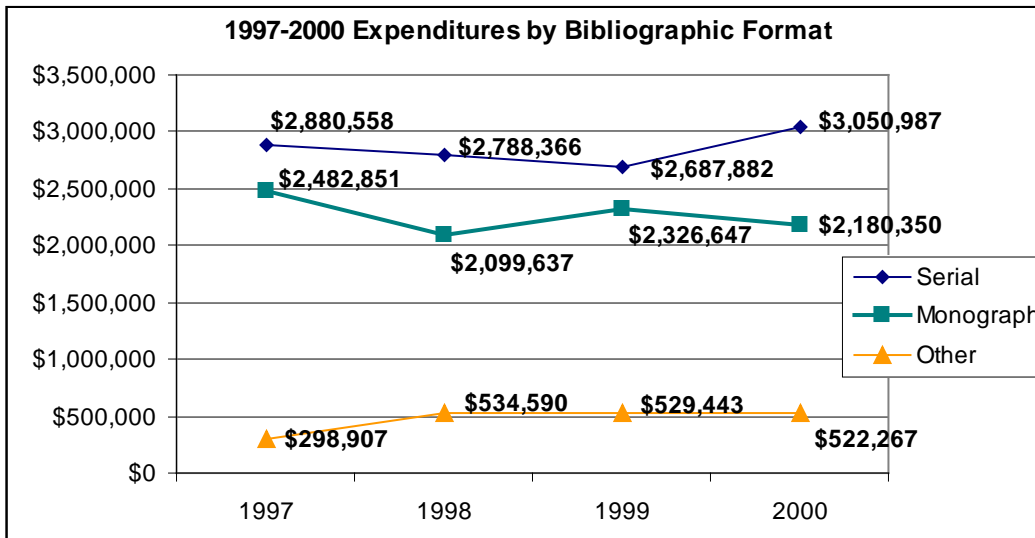


### Expenditures by Bibliographic Format

Serials cost a total of \$3,050,987 (53.0% of the budget); expenditures for monographs were a total of \$2,180,350 (37.9% of the budget). The remaining \$522,267 (9.1% of the budget) was spent on miscellaneous purchases, e.g., binding, postage, membership fees, and interlibrary loan expenses.



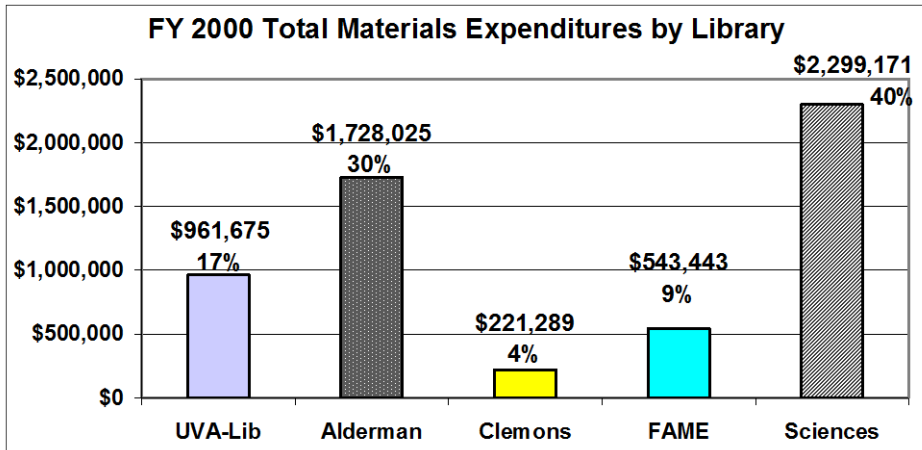
The chart below displays the recent trend in expenditures by bibliographic format.



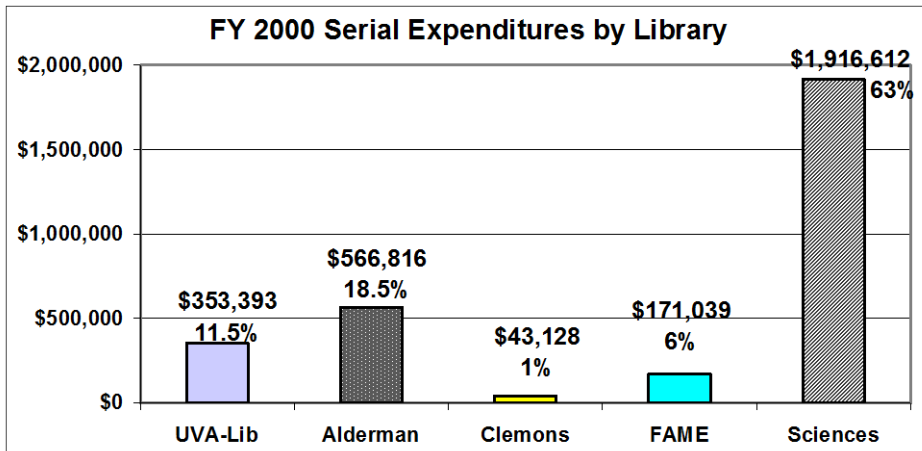
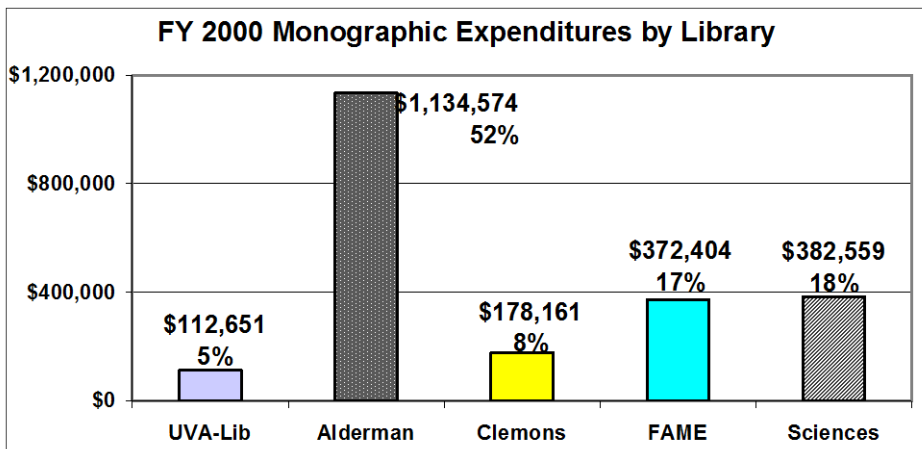
### Expenditures by Library Category

The University Library expenditures are grouped into five subject/library areas—Alderman (the main library for the humanities and social sciences), Clemons (the undergraduate readers library), the FAME libraries (the libraries for Fine Arts, Music, and Education), the Science Libraries (which include Engineering), and general system-wide expenditures (called UVALIB in the Sirsi system).

General (UVA-LIB) funds account for 16.7% of the total; Alderman spent 30% of the total; Clemons 3.8%; FAME 9.4%; and Sciences 40%.

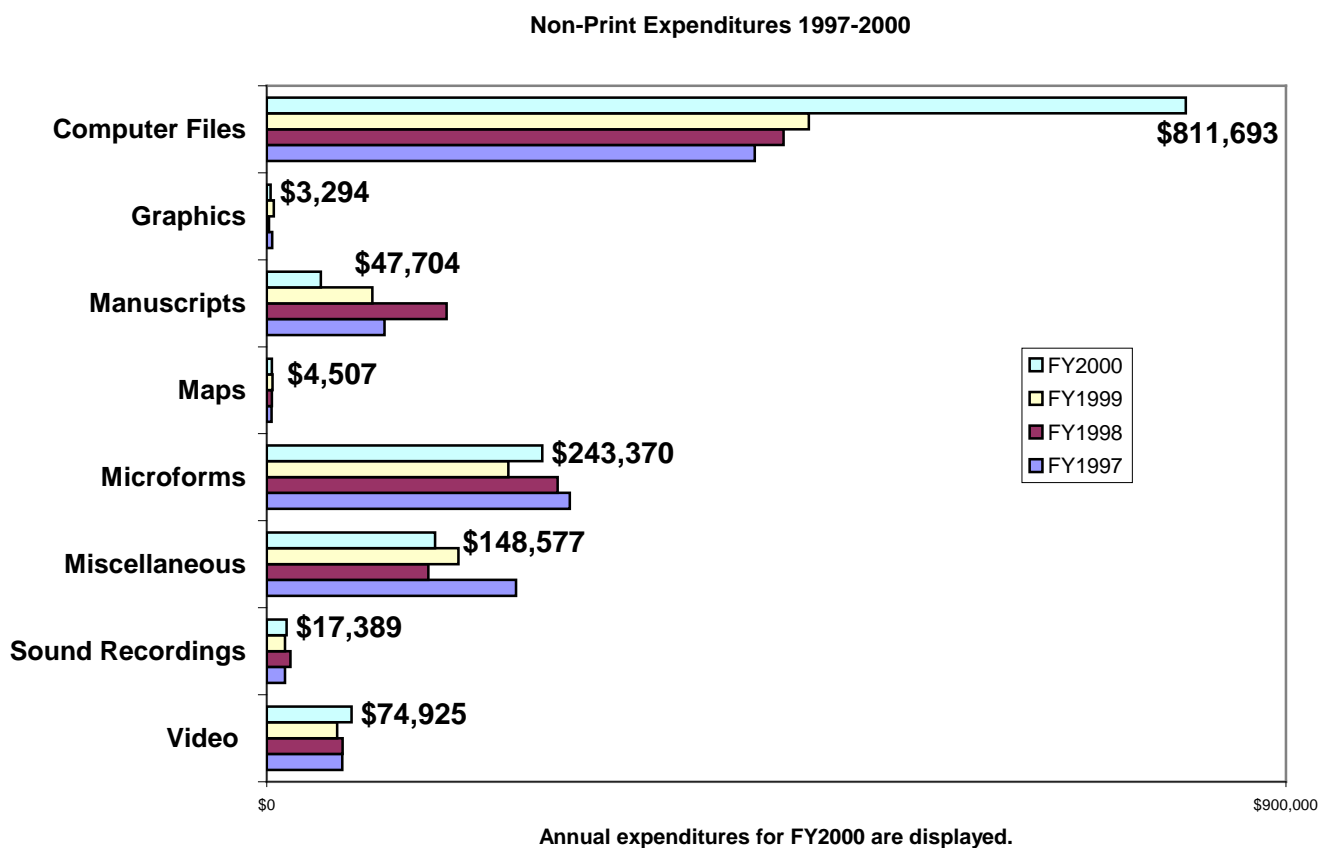


Among expenditures for monographs, the bulk went to Alderman-52% of the monographic total. The majority of the serial expenditures were by the Science libraries-63% of the serial total.



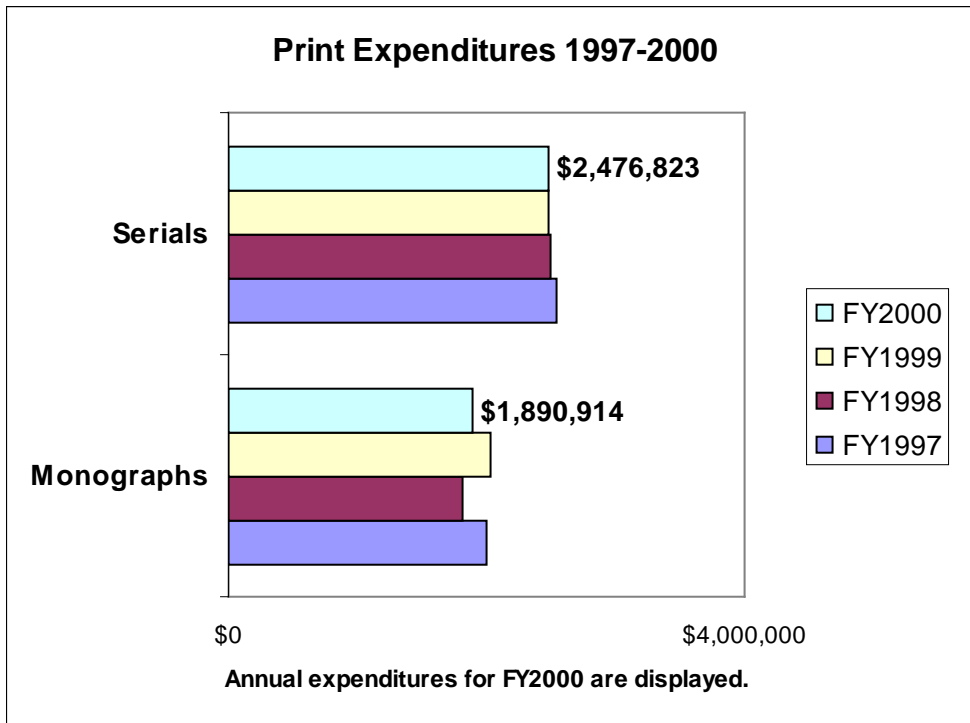
### Expenditures by Physical Format

A final breakdown by format follows. In these charts, print is separated from non-print so that the proportionally smaller numbers are visible. (Because of this, please note the different scales of each chart.) Four years of data are graphed in each chart, and the total expenditures for FY2000 are displayed.



FY2000 saw a large increase in expenditures for computer files. The unusual increase was a result of the purchase of a very large, multidisciplinary database, the Web of Science. Several academic departments and colleges of the University transferred money to the Library in order to facilitate purchase of this major resource.

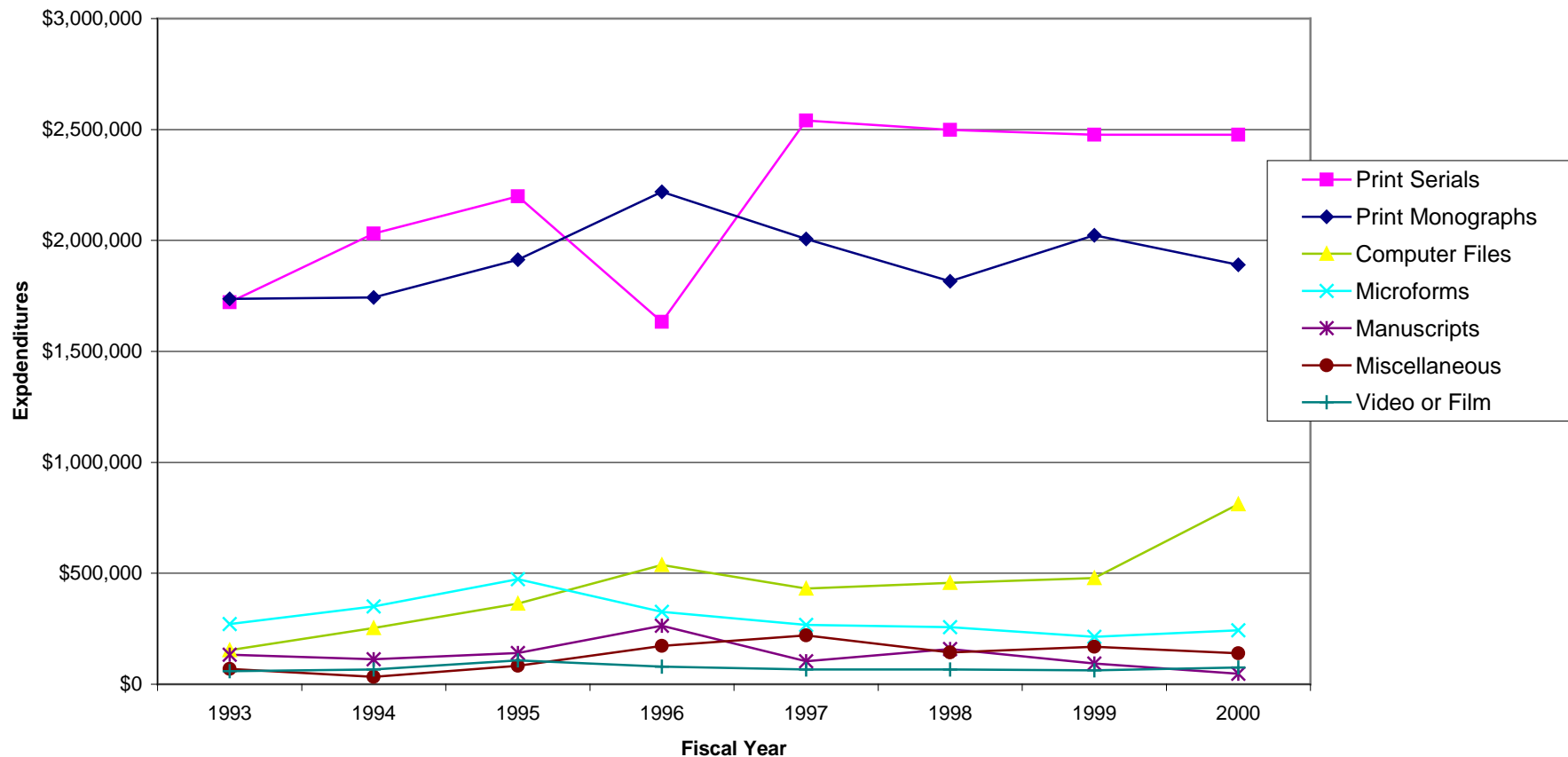
Print expenditures have been relatively consistent for the past four years, with serials continuing to require more funding than monographs.

Print materials continue to dominate expenditures, and the trend shows a gradual shift toward serials. Expenditures for computer files are generally growing, but the significantly higher FY2000 expenditures are a reflection of a single purchase, the *Web of Science* database. Microform and manuscript expenditures have trended downward; the other formats seem to have fluctuated without obvious direction. FY1996 was an anomalous year because we stopped pre-paying serials then and used the extra, one-time money to fund some major monographic projects.

The materials budget showed notable increases for two years in the mid-1990's. For the last six years, the budget has been basically flat, except for a one-time appropriation in FY2000 that was designated for the purchase of a major database, the *Web of Science*.

The totals in the table do not always agree with the total materials budget reported to ARL because ARL now puts binding expenditures in a separate category.

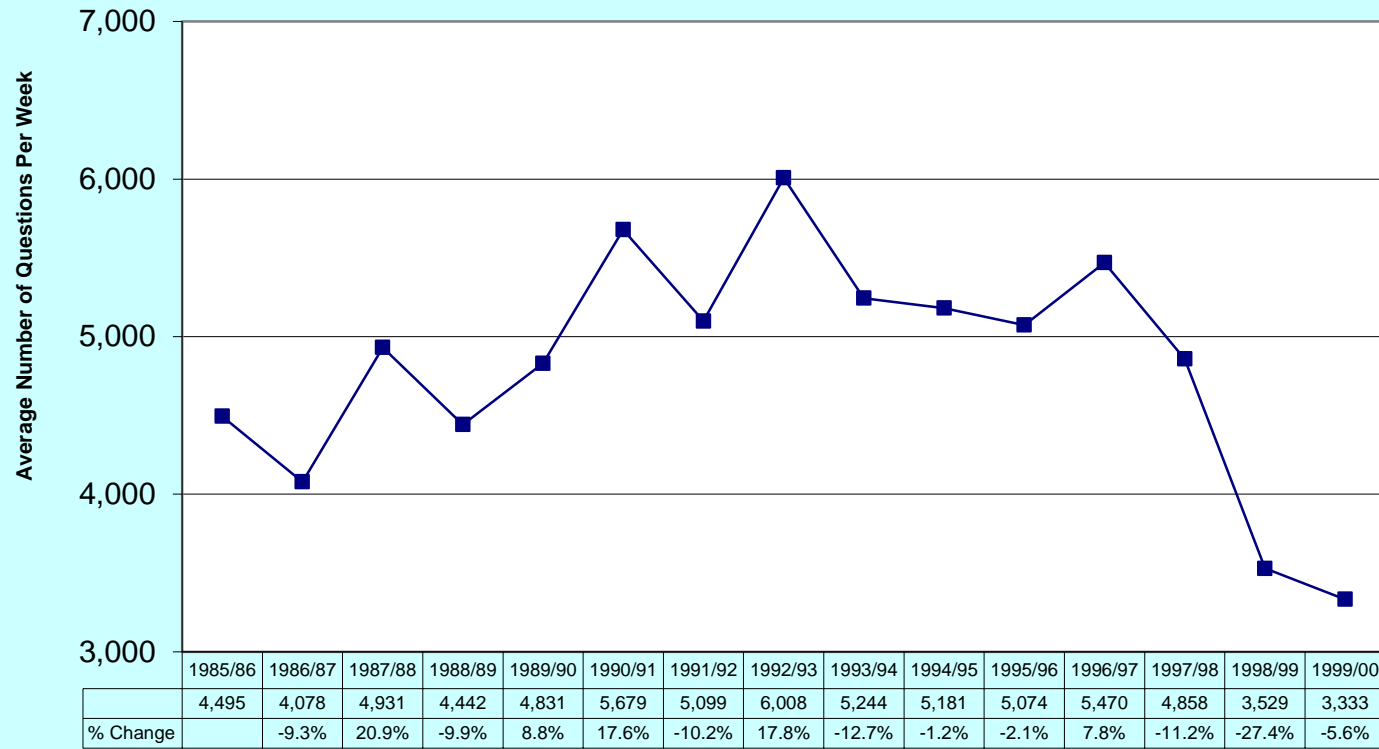

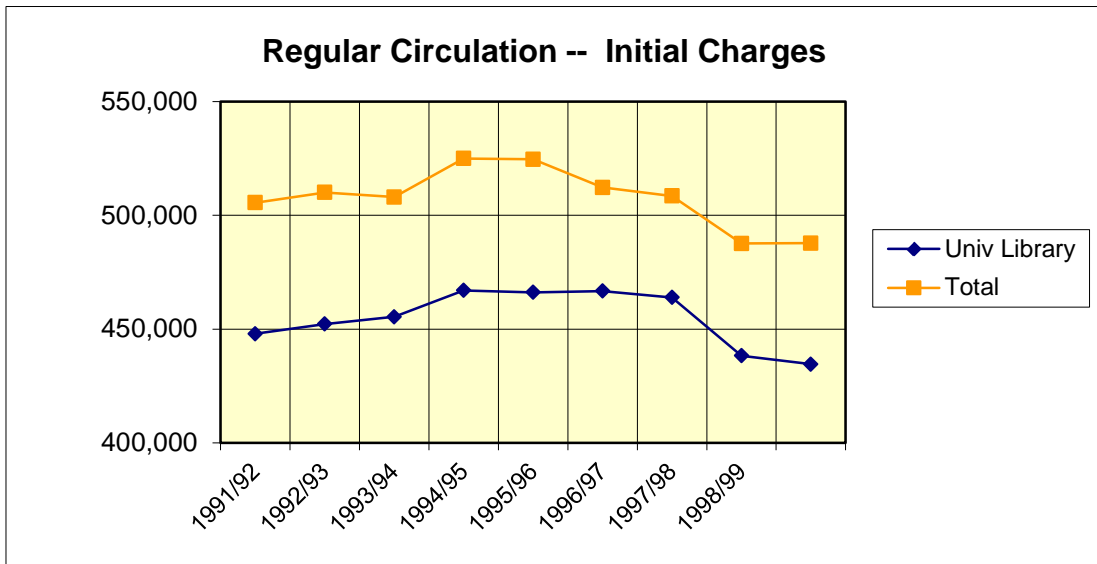

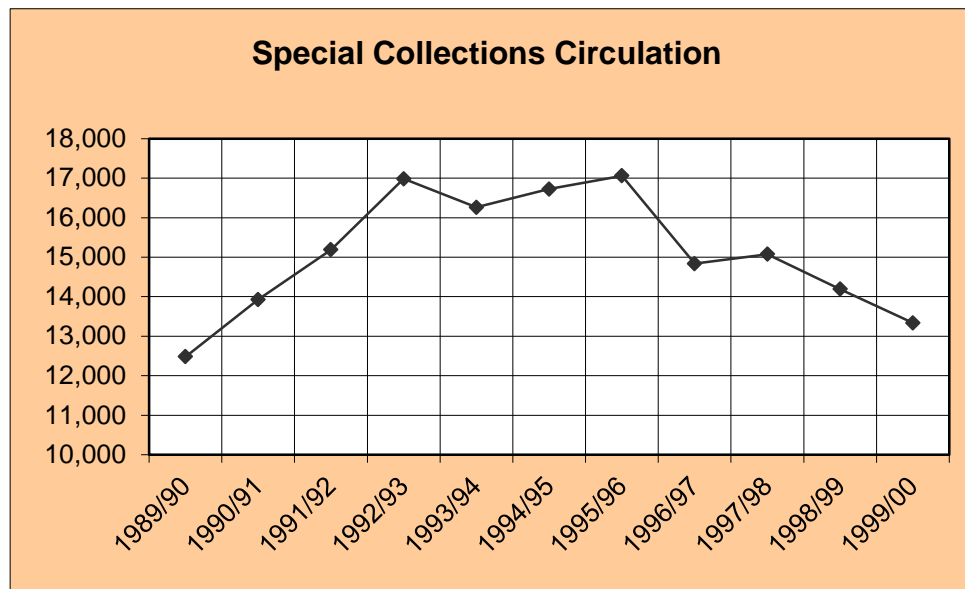

## Use of Web Resources at the University of Virginia Library Fiscal Year 2000

Counting the use of World Wide Web resources is an uncertain and evolving process. At the University Library we do not have all the statistics we would like, but we do know the use of our websites is quite high, and we know the use is growing rapidly.

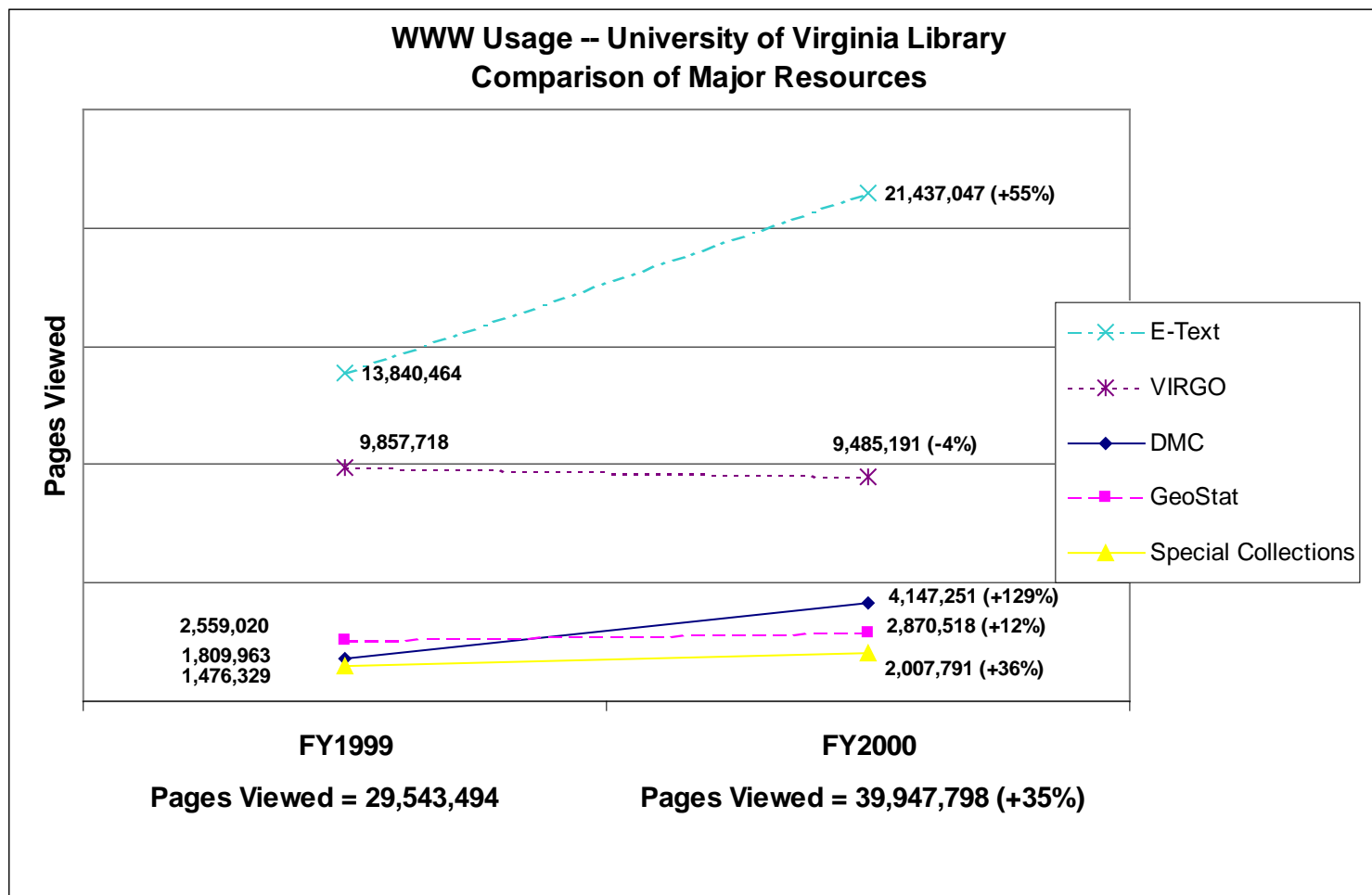
From the table below we see that over 47 million Library web pages were viewed in 1999/2000. Nearly 45% of the pages were from the Electronic Text Center. Next was VIRGO which was responsible for nine million views (20% of the total).

These numbers include only those web resources on servers controlled by the University Library. They do not include the many external databases and electronic journals to which the Library subscribes.

We cannot make an exact year to year comparison of usage of all library websites because the figures for FY1999 are incomplete. However, we do have comparable figures for several of the major library servers. Looking at just these servers, we find a 35% increase in pages viewed from FY1999 to FY2000. The chart on the following page demonstrates the trends.



Certain trends seem particularly noteworthy. The Electronic Text Center shows a dramatic increase, while VIRGO usage shows a slight decline. Among the other servers, we find increases ranging from 12% at GeoStat to 129% for the Digital Media Center. It seems clear that VIRGO usage, although currently high, is not a growth area, but all the other resources are growing significantly.

In this rapidly changing environment the University Library continues to search for the best and most accurate means of collecting web statistics. Whatever the outcome of the search we will continue to tally and to compare web usage from year to year and from resource to resource.

Electronic Journal Usage  
University of Virginia Library  
July 1999 – June 2000

Electronic journals are an increasingly important resource for the University Library. In 1999/2000 over \$300,000 of the materials budget was spent for electronic serials, including indexes and full-text journals. In addition the VIVA statewide consortium spent \$2,000,000 on access to electronic resources; all the VIVA resources are available to the U.Va. community.

We are just beginning to receive data on usage of the electronic journals. Although the data are far from complete, they indicate very high use. We were able to get data from only six databases of full-text electronic journals. However, from those seven databases, we recorded use of over 130,000 journal articles.

The University Library has never found a way to collect reliable statistics on the use of journals in traditional formats (paper and microform), so we cannot compare these numbers to the use of traditional journals. However, we know that these are large numbers, and we know they will increase in the future. Many of the major collections of full-text electronic periodical articles (e.g., Lexis-Nexis, Dow Jones, Springer-Verlag, OCLC Electronic Collections Online) are not yet providing statistics to us. Once we get numbers from these vendors, the totals are sure to rise substantially.

In the limited universe for which we have data, we find that use crosses disciplinary lines. The science journals are at the top of the list of most used titles, but social science journals are not far behind, and a number of humanities titles receive significant use. The chart on the attached page lists the top electronic journals in terms of use.
